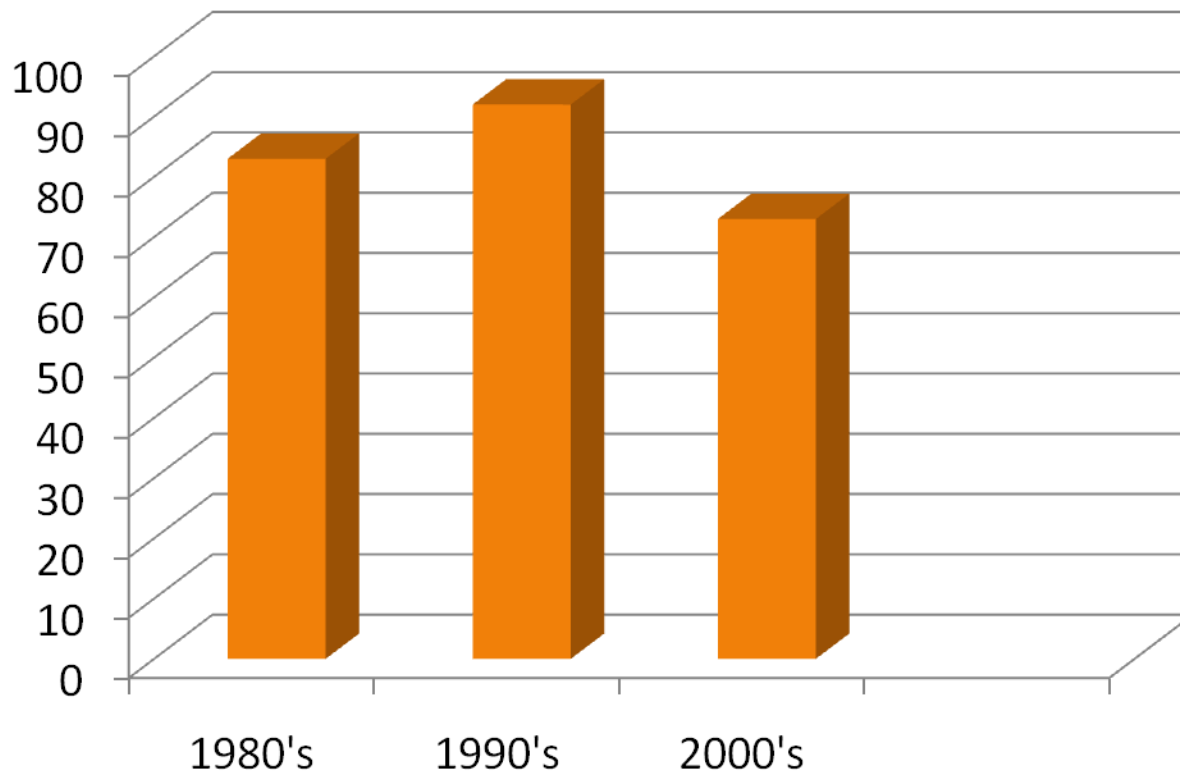

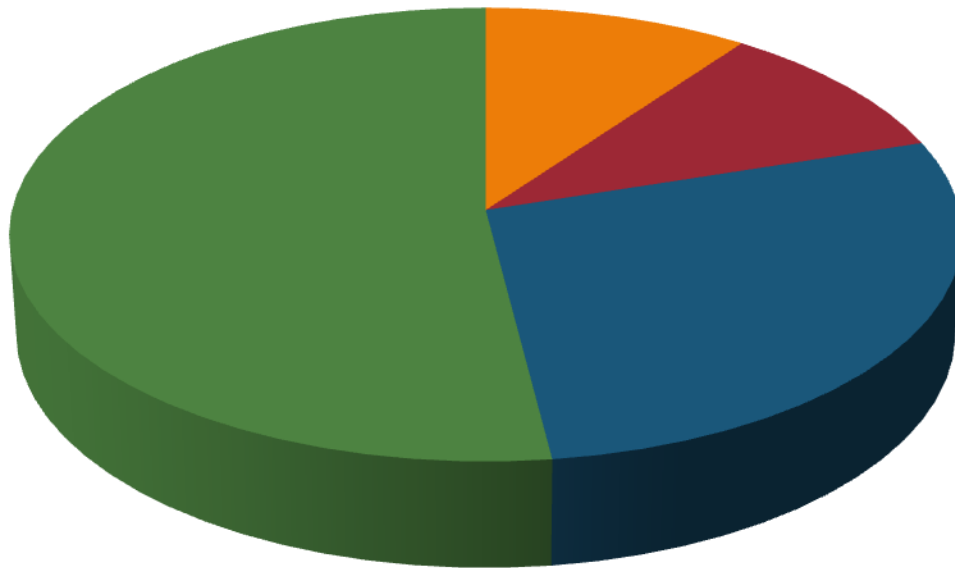




Agree that "Democracy is the best form of government"

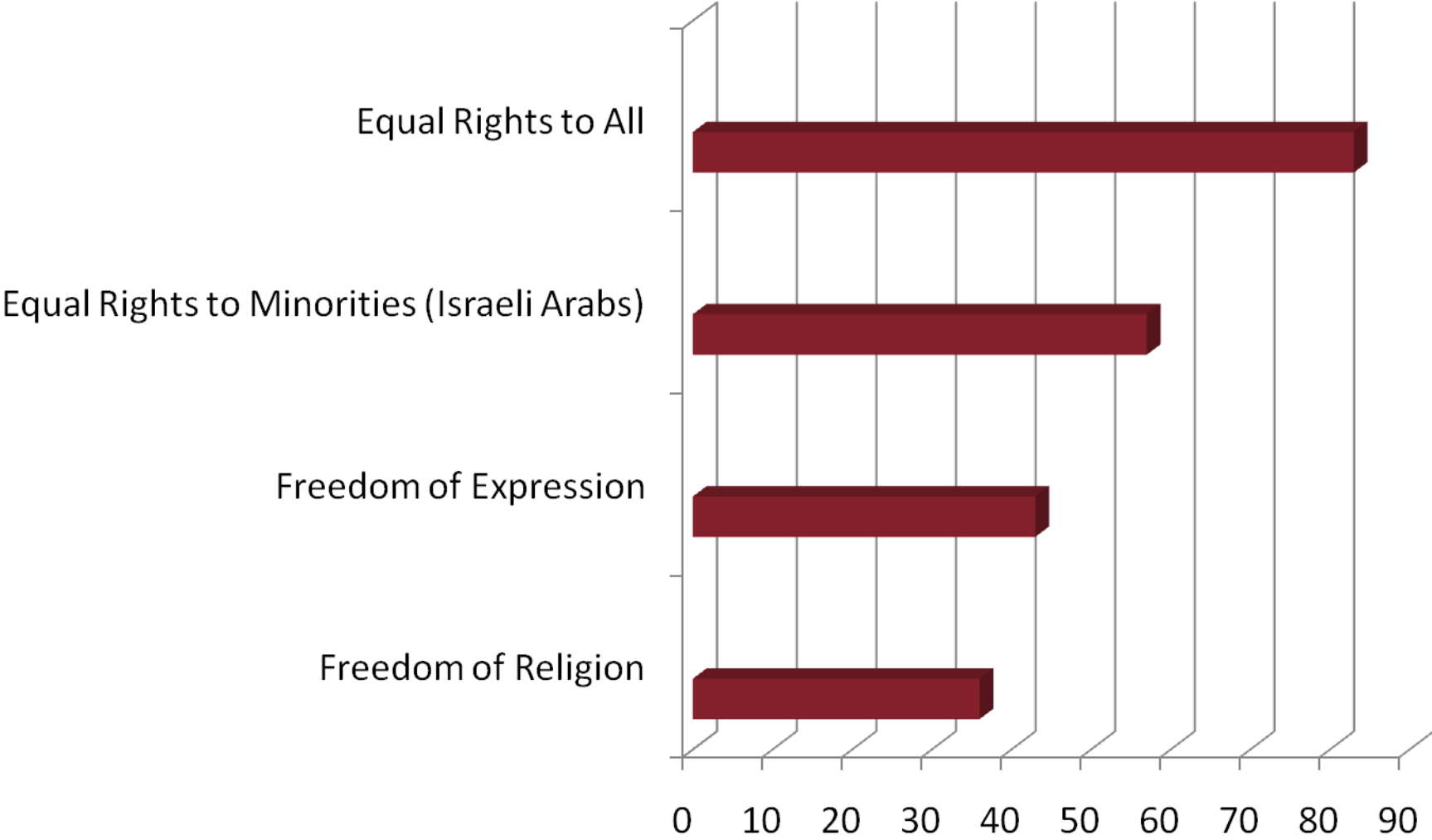


Structure of Israeli Society

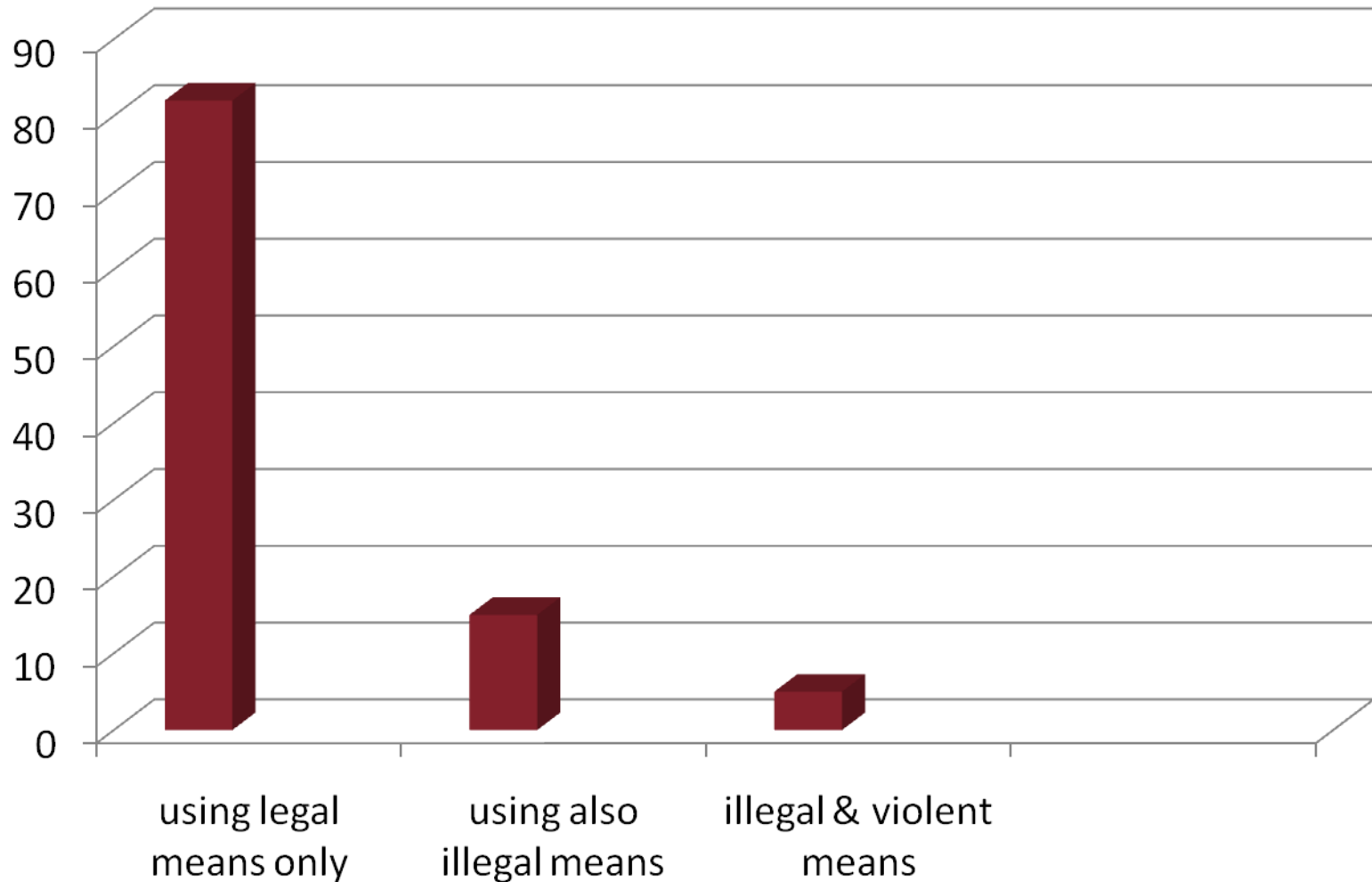


- ultra-orthodox - 9%

- secular - 55%

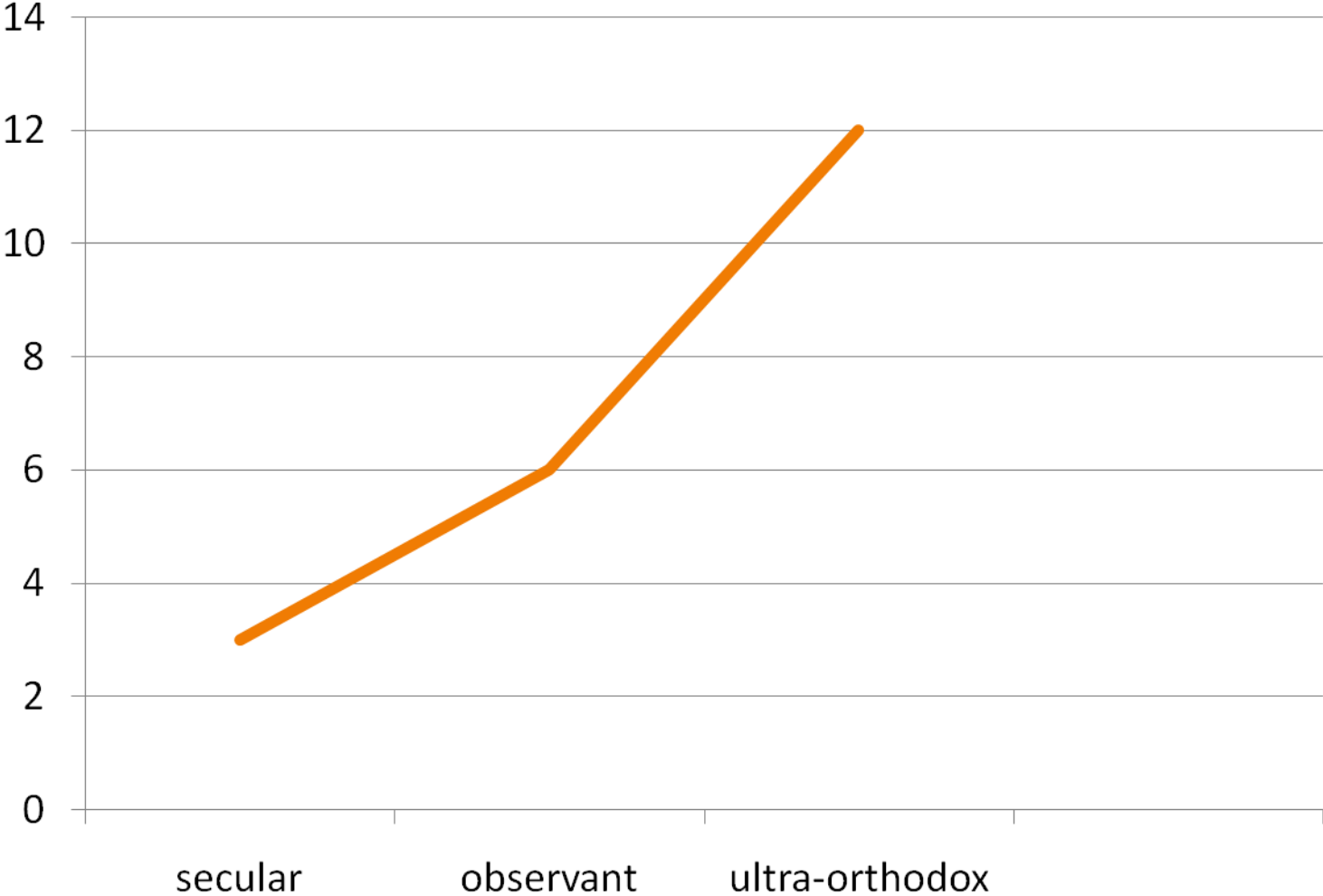
